


Who's coming?

Most are members of the National Association of Science Writers. An estimated 20% of NASW's journalist members also belong to the Association of Health Care Journalists or the Society of Environmental Journalists, reflecting the ways science writers look for stories across topics such as biomedicine and climate.





Guidelines

- All supported activities will be labeled as such, and sponsors will be prominently recognized. CASW and SCONC recognize that sponsored activities add value to the conference and will work to ensure that sponsors' activities, presence, and support are appreciated by attendees.
- Sponsor representatives will have the same access to attendees online, in the conference app, and in person, as do other attendees.
- Attendees will decide what personal and professional information to share with sponsors and hosts. Organizers do not share attendee info.
- Sponsor representatives, including support staff, will be required to abide by NASW's <u>Conference and Meeting Code of Conduct</u>.
- Any activities listed in the conference program must be open to all attendees.

Additional guidelines on access and accessibility, attention to dietary needs, transportation, and liability insurance apply to sponsor-organized and off-site events.



The **Council for the Advancement of Science Writing,** a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, welcomes support from hosts and sponsors whose values align with our historical mission to improve the quality and quantity of science news reaching the public. Sponsorship income helps offset the cost of the conference science program, provide hospitality and travel grants, and cover expenses such as planning, space rental, technology, and transportation.

ScienceWriters sponsorship guidelines recognize the independent, non-sponsored nature of conference events organized by our partner, the **National Association of Science Writers**, and the journalistic context of the joint NASW-CASW conference. NASW does not accept funding from outside sources.



Science Communicators of North Carolina, also a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, is proud to partner with CASW and NASW to produce ScienceWriters2024. Sponsors may choose to assign their contributions to SCONC.

If funds remain after all conference expenses are settled, they will be divided among the conference partners and used for ongoing activities in support of science journalism.
